

Oriental Bodywork Programs

All credits counting toward the 600-Hour Oriental Bodywork Program must be earned within two (2) calendar years from the date of enrollment. All credits counting toward the Associates of Applied Science-Oriental Bodywork must be earned within four(4) calendar years from the date of enrollment. Credits are earned and applied at the time of class completion per the designated schedule. Part-time students may be required to complete additional courses that were not part of the original curriculum due to program or professional changes. The following list outlines the requirements that must be successfully completed prior to graduation:



- Completed enrollment documentation, including but not limited to health verification forms, physician statement of health, enrollment agreement(s), curriculum vitae and notarized copies of licenses or certificates
- Satisfactory completion of all course work with a minimum grade of 70% in each course
- Exit and competency exams passed with a score of 80% or better and competency assessment completed satisfactorily
- Overall G.P.A. is 3.0
- Payment of all tuition, fees and other financial obligations to KCCM must be complete and all KCCM equipment/library materials must be returned or paid for

Graduation requirements may change over time in response to new national accreditation standards and other factors. Part-time students who do not meet graduation requirements in the specified period, are required to meet the graduation requirements in effect two years prior to their date of graduation, rather than those in effect at the time they began the program.
